For - This is the preposition "kata" which can mean according to but can also be used to express the goal or purpose ("for the purpose of", "to further") and finally can be translated in the sense of "with reference to, with respect to." Scholars differ on their interpretation of Paul's intended meaning but most favor the idea that Paul's apostolic mission was for the purpose of or the furtherance of Christian faith and knowledge.
