That they all may be one: Jesus envisioned the great multitude before the throne of God of every nation, race, language, class, and social level (Revelation 7:9-10). Jesus

prayed that they might rise above their different backgrounds and understand their unity; that they may all be as one.

Jesus prayed for His own to be kept **from the evil one**, the world he rules, and of all of his evil schemes and strategies.
